

October 2014 – Routine Inspections

The Department of Health & Human Services conducts sanitary inspections at such facilities as: restaurants, delis, cafeterias, schools, churches, daycare centers, boarding homes, hair salons, nail salons, barber shops, tattoo/body art shops, gyms, pet shops/pounds, youth camps and public pools. These inspections are conducted at least once per year and in response to complaints received from residents.

Satisfactory: At the time of the inspection, the establishment is found to be operating in compliance with the State law regarding retail food establishments.

Conditional: At the time of the inspection, the establishment is found not to be operating in substantial compliance with the State law regarding retail food establishments and was in violation of one or more provisions of the said law.

Unsatisfactory: At the time of the inspection, the establishment is found to be operating with one or more violations that constitute gross unsanitary or unsafe conditions that pose an imminent health hazard. Temporary closure is ordered.
